- What can you tell us about the applicant's religious experiences, spiritual maturity, vocational call, gifts for ministry, and need for spiritual growth?
- What leadership abilities has this applicant exhibited in the past? What potential for leadership do you see in this person for the future?
- Describe the applicant as a person; assess their strengths, limitations, relational skills, reactions to stressful situations and/or approaches to resolving conflicts.
