## **Qualifications:**

- 1. Lifeguard certification, First Aid/CPR certification
- 2. NC Boating License preferred
- 3. Desire to instruct and lead all waterfront activities including sailing, pool & canoeing in a Christian setting
- 4. Desire to take pride and responsibility in safety and enjoyment in all waterfront program areas
- 5. Ability to work with campers and staff as a teacher and group leader

**Responsible to:** Waterfront Leadership Team (Head Lifeguard, Sail Master, Assistant Sail Master, Waterfront Coordinator)

## **General Responsibilities:**

- 1. To conduct waterfront programs of instruction to all camper groups
- 2. To act as the on-duty lifeguard during all waterfront activities
- 3. To carry out all responsibilities assigned by the Waterfront Leadership Team

## **Specific Responsibilities:**

- 1. Instruct campers in basic canoeing/kayaking techniques and safety procedures
- 2. Instruct campers in basic sailing techniques and safety procedures
- 3. Interpret and enforce all rules of water safety
- Keep all supplies and equipment in good condition and make repairs as needed and instructed by the Waterfront Leadership Team
- 5. Assist in maintenance of all waterfront program areas
- 6. Assume active leadership during any use of waterfront facilities
- 7. Assist in teaching swim lessons if needed
- 8. In case of inclement weather, facilitate "rainy day" group games or activities with assigned group
- 9. Rig and unrig boats, operate power boats, and perform on-the-water rescue and assistance.
- 10. Lead sailing trips both on the water and on land.
- 11. Lead a trip prep classroom before each trip with the group and a debriefing after the trip has returned.
- 12. Participate in all camp activities
- 13. Serve as a support staff to a group of campers.
